⇒ **Navigators:** Picked up from Southern Middle, Turrentine Middle, and Western Middle by 3:45pm until 6:00pm each school day.

A healthy snack each day, time to socialize with friends, opportunity to do homework, organized games and sports, lots of physical activity, weekly "huddle times" with a focus on character development, and on Fridays we offer swimming and special clubs such as cooking club.
