After School Care and Navigator Fees:

Full-Time: Y Members	\$150	Program Participants	\$180
Part-Time Y Members	\$90	Program Participants	\$110
Navigator Y Members	\$105	Program Participants	\$130

Part-Time participants must be picked up by 4:30pm or only attend two days a week.
