YMCA After School Care provides a safe environment for your children to learn, grow and thrive. Our after school program focuses on implementing our core values into our daily activities while allowing you the opportunity to work knowing that your child is being cared for in a nurturing and structured environment.

- After School care is provided for children in kindergarten through 5th grade.
- Our Navigator Program is for students in 6th through 8th grade.
- The Y provides transportation from seven elementary schools and one middle school in the Alamance-Burlington School System.
- A healthy snack and dinner is provided daily.
- The Y offers care from school dismissal until 6:00pm.
- We offer a multiple child discount of \$10 off per child per month.
- We will not offer After School care on Early Release Dates.

*Part-Time participants can only attend two days a week.			
Navigator Y Members	\$110	Program Participants	\$140
\$25 registration fee is due at the time of registration per family.			

Draft Dates:

Payments will be drafted monthly on the first of each month beginning on September 1st with the last draft taking place on May 1st. Drafts will not be prorated based on the number of days of school each month. Teacher Work Days (11 per school year) are included in the monthly draft. Snow Days, Spring Break, and Christmas Break will require additional registration fees to attend.
