- ◆ **Camp Horizons, located at the YMCA, is for rising Kindergarten through 5th Grade.**

- ◆ **Camp Frontier, located on Bass Mountain Road in Snow Camp, is for rising 1st - 7th Grade.** A more traditional outdoor camp, activities include horseback riding, canoeing, hiking trails, swimming in the outdoor pool, archery, fishing, tennis, art and crafts, sports and more.
- ◆ **Camp Outback, located on Bass Mountain Road in Snow Camp, is for rising 8th Grade.** This camping opportunity is designed for the older youth. At this age, youth are interested in more adventurous camp experiences so we offer courageous field trips like whitewater rafting and more. Service learning opportunities are also provided.

CAMP FRONTIER PONY CLUB:

CAMP FRONTIER AND CAMP HORIZONS FEES:

CAMP OUTBACK FEES:

(Price is for each two week session, session will not be pro-rated)

One Child: \$230 for Y Members \$270 for Program Participants

Multiple Children: \$210 per child for Y Members \$250 per child for Program Participants
