Camp Frontier Pool

Nestled in the beautiful wooded acres of southern Alamance County, our 25 yard outdoor pool is the place to cool off on summer nights and weekends! Toddlers have their own play area - just 2 feet deep, and the more adventurous can dive for objects or play "Sharks & Minnows" in our 11 feet deep end. Adults will have just as much fun, playing with the kids, lounging on the deck or swimming laps during the hourly pool breaks. Vending machines and bathrooms/showers conveniently located just off pool deck.

This year due to the NCDHSS Interim guidance for Public Pools, Camp Frontier Pool will be operating differently to abide by the guidelines. We will not be offering a Camp Pool Membership. We will be accepting Guest Fees at the Gate. Under Phase 2 guidelines we will be limiting admittance to 40 Swimmers for a 2 hour time limit. At least every 2 hours the staff will disinfect and clean the high touch areas. We will be using a reservation system to reserve your space. Open spaces will be first come first serve. Reservation system time slots will be open from 12:00 AM the operating day prior until 5:00 AM the day. Members will only be allowed to reserve one time slot per day. Any open time slots will be first come first serve. Everyone entering the pool area will be screened according to the guidelines. Members will need to exit the pool immediately after their time slot.

Pool Policies & Rules

- Please, show your membership cards and sign in at the lifeguard station at each visit.
- All children 12 & under *must be actively supervised* by a parent/guardian in the pool. The parent/guardian must pay to enter the facility.
- ALL CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 12 MUST BE SWIM TESTED. Please have your child swim tested by the lifeguard if you think they are deep water swimmers.
- Patron use of Camp Frontier is limited to the pool area (supervised), the children's playground adjacent to the pool (unsupervised) and to the parking lot (unsupervised). All other areas of the camp are not available to patrons, unless under the supervision of YMCA staff and/or with permission of the YMCA Aquatics Director and Camp Directors.
- Lost and found items will be kept for a maximum of 7 days and then given to charity.
- In the event of inclement weather, such as thunder & lightning storms, tornado watch/warnings or other conditions the lifeguards deem dangerous, pool patrons will be asked to vacate the premises. A re-opening time will be posted at the time of evacuation, if applicable.

NO REFUNDS will be given

- Please shower before entering the pool.
- Please wear proper swim suit. No cutoffs, gym shorts, or t-shirts
- Swim diapers MUST be worn on all children who are not "potty-trained".
- No diving in shallow end.
- No running on the deck.
- No flotation devices in deep end. (This includes lifejackets)
- Only Coast Guard-Approved Devices may be worn by non-swimmers. For your child's safety, inflatable wings, etc. are not allowed.

Additional Pool guidelines to abide by NCDHSS Guidelines:

- You need to have a Covid-19 Acknowledgement signed
- Social Distancing should be followed at all times - in and out of the water
- Maximum In-Water Occupancy - 40 swimmers
- Must bring your own equipment/toys - no YMCA equipment will be available except Lifejackets
- Showers will be for rinsing off only
- Come in your suit / leave in your suit
- Pool bathrooms are not for changing
- No congregating on YMCA property / swimmers will need to leave the deck as soon as possible when finished/time is up
- Do not approach the lifeguard - maintain 6 ft distance
