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TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Welcome to YBAC!!! This document will explain to you the terms of participation for the YBAC Hurricanes Swim Team (aka YBAC). Please read this document carefully as you will be required to sign your swimmer's registration form stating that you have read, understand, and agree to all the terms and conditions outlined in this document.

REGISTRATION

New swimmers begin the registration process at a placement session where the swimmer will be evaluated in the water and a YBAC staff member will explain the program and registration process. Registration packets must be turned in to the front desk staff member by the end of the first week of practices. ALL the following must be included in the registration for it to be complete: 1) a signed and completed registration form, 2) a signed and completed draft authorization form and 3) a copy of child's birth certificate or NCS Proof of Age form. If you are transferring from another USA Swimming club we will also need a completed NC Swimming Transfer Form.

The registration fee is paid once per swim year and is required and non-refundable. It will be charged immediately when the registration is processed. Following your swimmer's placement session, you can try out the program for one week.

PAYMENT OPTIONS AND FEE SCHEDULE

The required and non-refundable registration fee (\$35 for Technique and Fitness Program; \$100 for Competitive Program) will not be prorated or waived for any reason, except those with official school documentation of reduced or free lunch program (\$15), regardless of start date or number of months your swimmer plans to participate. The registration fee is paid once per swimming year (August – July). All swimmers pay a program fee based on the swimmer's training group. Those in the Competitive and High Performance Group can pay either monthly or the season or yearly:

YBAC 2	\$75/month	or	\$702/year
YBAC 3	\$85/month	or	\$795/year
YBAC 4	\$90/month	or	\$842/Year
YBAC 5	\$100/month	or	\$935/Year

Multiple Swimmers: Families with 3 or more children will receive the following training fee discounts (Registration fees must be paid in full):

1 st & 2 nd Child – regular price (highest training fees)	3 rd child – 50% discount
4 th child – 75% discount	5 th child or more – free

YMCA does offer financial assistance for those in need. Application forms can be obtained at the front desk of the YMCA

Membership with YBAC Hurricanes allows gives the swimmer full membership to the YMCA. This is only during times of enrollment, unless they are already a paying member.

YBAC monthly program fees are drafted on the 1st of each month. We do not invoice or allow you to pay monthly by check. If there are special circumstances, please talk with Finance Department at the YMCA. I authorize the Alamance County Community YMCA to draft the payments from my account for my child(ren) for any fees associated with the YBAC Hurricanes Program that require payments to be made on a bank draft. I understand that should any draft not be honored by my bank for any reason, the draft will be re-deposited and a \$25.00 service charge will be added to my account.

Those paying by the season will need to pay the fee by September 1st. Those paying the yearly fee need to have the payment by September 1st. Those wishing to pay the yearly fee in other terms should talk with Patricia Brewer at the YMCA.



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The YMCA may use images of my child(ren) as a YMCA program participant in internal and external promotional material. This includes any printed material, broadcast, and print advertisement, promotional videos and the YMCA website which are produced or published by the YMCA. I also permit the YMCA and/or the media to use images of my child in broadcast and print media news coverage of the YMCA.

WEBSITE AND SOCIAL MEDIA

_____ The YBAC team website is www.acymca.org/YBAC. We will use email, the team website, as well as our Facebook sites, to communicate the majority of all information about practice changes, upcoming meet information, special team events, fundraising, volunteer opportunities, etc. It is critical that you get in the habit of checking these websites on a regular basis for updates. Also, please keep all contact information and your swimmer's membership information up to date with the YBAC Office, including phone numbers, email addresses, etc.

GROUP CHANGES AND CANCELLATIONS

_____ If at some point your swimmer needs to change practice groups or cancel swim team, you must complete a **Change Form from the front desk of the YMCA**. For group changes, the request must be submitted and approved BEFORE the group change occurs. Swimmers will not be allowed to switch practice groups solely based on verbal approval from their coach.

_____ For cancellations, the **Cancel Form** must be received by the YMCA Front Desk by **20th of the preceding month that you wish to have cancelled**. Refunds will NOT be granted if a draft occurs for a cancelled month if the form was not received in time. Verbally notifying your child's coach or the front desk is not sufficient cancellation notice and will not stop your draft without the completed cancellation form.

TEAM SUIT AND TEAM APPAREL

_____ All swimmers are given a YBAC team t-shirt, and swim cap when they register. A YBAC team swimsuit and some training equipment are encouraged for swimmers. Training equipment and additional team apparel items like warm-ups, swim bags, etc. are available for purchase through our team dealer. YBAC is sponsored by Speedo.

FUNDRAISING

_____ The YBAC Swim Team generates revenue through various fundraisers throughout the year to help keep program fees low and to enhance all aspects of our program. We rely on the involvement of our entire membership to support these activities as they have a direct impact on special team events such as our annual awards banquet, buses for team trips, and the ability to attend major championship meets and team social events. It is an expectation that all YBAC members will participate in our fundraising activities.

VOLUNTEERING

_____ The YBAC Swim Team is known across the region for hosting highly successful swim meets. When hosting meets, it is expected that we will have the necessary people to run the meet. The success of these events is dependent upon every family volunteering in some way throughout the year. **It is an expectation that all YBAC members will volunteer as frequently as possible when called upon.**

CODE OF CONDUCT

_____ All members of the YBAC Swim Team, including both swimmers and parents, are expected to conduct themselves in a courteous, responsible and exemplary manner at all times. We recognize that the reputation of YBAC is dependent upon our conduct and behavior and we must do our best to ensure that our reputation is maintained to the highest possible standard.
