Young Achievers Academy Fees:

A \$25 registration fee is required for each registrant to hold a spot in the program.

This fee is **non - refundable once the program begins.**

Y Members: \$110 per week

Program Participant: \$130 per week

Piano Club:

Piano Club is an added program for all ages enrolled in our Young Achievers Academy. Students will receive one hour of individualized instruction once a week. The cost for a one week session is \$20.00. For more information email Ally.

Kids Fun Days and Holiday Camps:

When students are out of school due to a teacher workday or are on a break during the school year, the YMCA is here to help! We will provide your children with a fun and safe way to spend their day! We offer care from 7:30am to 6:00pm on all Kids Fun Days and Holiday Camp dates. To avoid a late fee, pre-registration is required.

Kids Fun Days Dates:

- September 21st (Free for children enrolled in our Young Achievers Academy).

- January 18th and 19th
- March 24th

Fees: Free for Full Time After School kids, \$15 per day for Part Time and Navigators, \$25 per day for all other non after school kids.

Holiday Camp Dates:

- Winter Break: December 21st—January 1st
- Spring Break: April 5th-9th

Fees: \$15 per day for all After School Participants, \$25 per day for all other non after school kids.

Limited financial assistance is available for qualifying families on a first come, first serve basis. Spots are limited so you are encouraged to apply early.

Qualifying for financial assistance does not guarantee you a spot, you must register your child and make payment arrangements in order to be guaranteed a spot.
